



Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Marion County, Arkansas; an Ordinance to be entitled:

An Ordinance to amend the 2020 budget, Ordinance 2019-86.

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Marion County, Arkansas; an Ordinance to be entitled:

An ordinance to control spending from the 2020 budget for the months of May, June and July, 2020 due to the National, State and local emergencies due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the resulting loss of revenues to the county.

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization and the United States Federal Government have declared a pandemic due to COVID-19, and

WHEREAS, the anticipated revenue for the State of Arkansas and Marion County for 2020 has been greatly affected by the Pandemic, and

WHEREAS, the Quorum Court wants to keep as many county employees as possible without layoffs,


Article 1. The Quorum Court herein enacts a budget reduction of 10% across the board for the months of May, June and July, 2020. The reduction will be 10% of the Year to Date balance of the May 1, 2020 budget detail, in other words, the bottom line of the budget, not any specific category.

Article 2. These budget reductions shall be reviewed bimonthly to determine if further budget reductions are needed.

Article 3. All ordinances not in conflict with ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Article 4: Emergency Clause. It is hereby determined that this ordinance is essential for the safety, health and welfare of the citizens of Marion County. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the immediate safety, health and welfare of Marion County shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.


AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO MOVE MONIES FROM THE ADDITIONAL  
MOTOR FUEL TAX FUND (ACT 416 OF 2019) INTO THE 2020 OPERATING BUDGET.


Whereas: The following funds will be appropriated into the 2000-0200 operating  
budget to cover the cost of monies that were moved thru a line item transfer for  
the use of the Counties portion of a State Aid Road of resurfacing of HWY 101.  
These monies were moved from 2000-0200-4005 into 4008 to cover this cost.

Appropriate \$24,620.00 from Fund 2003 into 2000-0200-4005 Vehicles. This is just to  
cover the amount transferred.
