Whereas, it is the obligation of the Quorum Court of the County of Marion, State of Arkansas to declare that a vacancy exists in the office of the County Treasurer as of August 1, 2020, in the County of Marion, State of Arkansas, as authorized by Amendment 55 of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas and Arkansas Code Annotated 14-14-1309;

Whereas, the Quorum Court is further authorized by Amendment 55 of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas and Arkansas Code Annotated 14-14-1310 to address and fill the vacancy in the unexpired term by appointment;





EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1

WHEREAS: ACA 14-14-1310 provides for the interim filing of vacancies for the Office of Marion County Judge during times of emergency: and

WHEREAS: ACA 14-14-1310 was to add an additional subsection (c)(1)(A) entitled EMERGENCY VACANCIES which states, "During a declaration of emergency or circumstances that warrant a declaration of emergency under §12-75-107 or §12-75-108, a vacancy in the office of county judge due to death or disability to the degree of inability to perform the duties of office shall be temporarily filled by executive order of the county judge issued prior to the incapacity of the county judge, designating three(3) persons in succession to fill the vacancy of the office of county judge on an interim basis until such time as the vacancy is filled by the quorum court as provided by this chapter or the disability of the county judge is abated."

NOW, THEREFORE, I (John Massey) Marion County Judge, acting under the authority vested in me by Arkansas Code Annotated 14-14-1310, do hereby designate the following persons to fill the position of county judge in the following line of succession, during times of emergency,
