AN ORDINANCE MOVING ALL 911 RESPONSIBILITIES BACK UNDER THE COUNTY JUDGE FROM THE SHERIFF.

ARTICLE 1. Arkansas law directs that the County Judge shall designate a coordinator for the public safety communications center, (911). By separate document, the OEM director will be designated as the coordinator for the public safety communication center.

ARTICLE 2. Currently there are still 3 dispatchers paid from the sheriff's funds. The funding for these dispatchers shall be moved to the Office of County Judge's Budget. To fund this expenditure, 5% taken from the 1801-0200 Fund and transferred into 3020 to cover the cost of the 3 dispatchers.

ARTICLE 3: All ordinances not in conflict with this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>ARTICLE 4.</u> This Ordinance herein enacted is an appropriation ordinance and therefore it is effective immediately.
