ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:



AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR

ARTICLE 1. WHEREAS, there is a need to appropriate unappropriated monies in the County Road
Fund 2000 and raise anticipated revenue \$36,000. And appropriate as follows:

An Emergency Ordinance amending Ordinance 2018-73 identified as the Numbers and Compensation of County employees.

Article 1. The following non-elected positions are authorized at the per annum base hourly rate and amended as follows for the Transfer Station/Solid Waste:

Ordinance 2019-30

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Marion County, Arkansas; an Ordinance to be entitled:

An ordinance amending the annual operating budget, Ordinance 2018-72 for the calendar year 2019 for Marion County, Arkansas.

Article 1. The Quorum Court passed Ordinance 2019-18 in April allowing for the Clerk's office to transfer all the funds from the Circuit Judges Jurors and Witnesses line items into 1000-0102-3092. At the time the amount of monies going to be transferred was unavailable due to a possible jury trial, between the time the packets went out and the meeting date. Such jury trial happened, and when the jurors were paid out of 1000-0401-3092, payment to the jurors resulted in a negative balance of \$1752.50. Before the monies can be transferred into the Clerk's office line item, this negative balance needs to be taken care

Article 3. The Quorum Court passed Ordinance 2019-20 in April allowing for the deletion of line item 1000-0109-1002 Election Services – Part Time, and moving the funds into line item 1000-0109-1003 – Extra Help/PerDiem. However, before the Quorum Court meeting, the fiscal quarter ended and the state taxes were subtracted out of that line item in the amount of \$4.00. Resulting in a negative balance.

Article 6. Special Funds Total


In Section E Special Funds, the total is shown as \$1,430,078.60 and should be \$1,591,731.60. This is due to the 3011-0105 Re-Appraisal Cost Fund and 3088-0600 Library State Aid fund being left out of the formula in the Excel spreadsheet. Thus this will change the grand total of the budget from \$8,143,604.55 to \$8,305,258.44.

Article 7. Jury Reimbursement

The Clerk submitted the jury reimbursement to the state for the first quarter of 2019, and received a reimbursement of \$2600.00, and deposited such with the Treasurer. This money needs to be put back into the jury and witness line item 1000-0102-3092.

Therefore, after raising the anticipated revenue by \$2600.00, the Treasurer is ordered to transfer these funds into 1000-0102-3092.

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING A MUNICIPAL NOTE PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROCURING 3 (THREE) 2019 CATAPILLIAR GRADERS 140M3'S. ^{D.C.}

WHEREAS, Marion County, AR desires to enter into that certain note purchase Agreement dated on or about May 14, 2019 by and between Marion County, AR and First Service Bank for the purpose of procuring (3) three 2019 140 M3 Graders. The Note Holder desires to designate the obligations evidenced by this Agreement as "short-term financing obligations" authorized by Amendment 78 of the Arkansas Constitution Act 1808 of the Acts of Arkansas 2001. The obligations evidenced by this Agreement, along with all other "Short-Term financing Obligations" issued by the lessee equal five percent or less of the assessed value of taxable property located within Marion County as determined by the last tax assessment completed prior to the issuance of this Agreement. The Note holder (First Service Bank) desires to designate this Agreement as a "qualified tax exempt obligation" of Marion County, AR for the purposes of section 265 (b) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Marion County, AR desires to designate John Massey, Marion County Judge as an authorized signer of the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF MARION COUNTY, AR

Section 1. The Marion County, AR enter into a Municipal Note Agreement with First Service Bank for the purpose of procuring (3) three 2019 Caterpillar 140M3 Graders.

Section 2. That Marion County, AR desires to designate the obligations evidenced by the Municipal Note Agreement dated on or about May 14th 2019 by and between Marion County, AR and First Service Bank as a "Short-Term Financing obligations in the amount of \$625,503.00 as authorized by Amendment 78 of the Arkansas Constitution and Act 1808 of the Acts of Arkansas 2001.

Section 3. That the Municipal Note Agreement dated as of May 14, 2019 by and between the Marion County, AR and First Service Bank is designated by the Marion


County, AR was a "qualified tax exempt obligation" for the purposes of Section 265 (b) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended.

Section 4. That Marion County, AR designates John Massey, County Judge as an authorized signer of the Municipal Note Agreement dated on or about May 14, 2019 by and between Marion County, AR and First Service Bank.
