

**Ordinance 2019- 32**

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Marion County, Arkansas; an Ordinance to be entitled:

An ordinance amending the annual operating budget, Ordinance 2018-72 for the calendar year 2019 for Marion County, Arkansas.

Article 1. Whereas, Marion County has been having a record number of jury trials, it has become necessary to create a separate category in the budget strictly for paying bills for the jury.

According to the Marion County Treasurer there is approximately \$13,000 in unappropriated money in County General.

Therefore, anticipated revenues should be raised by \$10,000 and appropriated as follows:

1000-0405 – Jurors and Witnesses

Personal Services

1000-0405-1002 Jury Per Diem \$9000.00

Supplies

1000-0405-2001 General Supplies \$500.00

1000-0405-2005 Food \$500.00

Article 2. On the passage of this ordinance all remaining monies in the Clerk’s Office budget will be transferred by court order to 1000-0405 Jurors and Witnesses.

Article 3. This ordinance herein enacted is an appropriation ordinance and therefore, it is effective immediately.





ORDINANCE 2019-35

Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Marion County, Arkansas, an Ordinance to be entitled:

An Ordinance amending the job titles and numbers in compensation for the road department.

WHEREAS, the current Road Foreman Position will be dropped to an Equipment Operator I position, There will be 2 Working Road Foreman's appointment from within the department. The monies from the difference of an Equipment Operator I and Road Foreman will be split between the two foreman's.

Article 1. Amend current Road Foreman max salary from \$17.50 to \$14.85, Equipment Operator I max salary.

Article 2. Amend 2 current Equipment Operator III positions to Working Road Foreman positions. Salaries will increase from \$15.85 to \$17.17 max salary.

Whereas when job titles were changed in 2017, it was stated that four Equipment Operator III positions would be dropped, three of those positions to Equipment Operator I positions and one to an Equipment Operator II upon the retirement of the four employees that were grandfathered into the current positions. This will alter the change in the future so only three will need to be dropped upon retirement of employees.

Article 3. Emergency Clause: It is hereby determined that this Ordinance is essential for the safety, health and welfare of the citizens of Marion County. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance being necessary to have County Numbers and Compensation records accurately reflect actual employment position and compensation, shall be in full force and effective back dated until June 5<sup>th</sup> 2019, to reflect the beginning of the new pay period.
