3051-0100 Transfer State Waste Tire





Be it enacted by the Quorum Court of Marion County, Arkansas; an Ordinance to be entitled:

An ordinance amending the annual operating budget, Ordinance 2018-72 for the calendar year 2019 for Marion County, Arkansas

Article 1. Appropriate unappropriated money in the amount of \$50000.00 from 3403 County Building Improvement Fund as follows:

Usually this transfer is done by Court Order, but in a discussion with Legislative Audit, they now want it done by Ordinance.

These funds are to cover an anticipated shortage in County General until the 2018 taxes have been collected. These monies will be returned to the County Building Fund when these funds become available.

Following the passage of this ordinance the County Treasurer is ordered to transfer the monies in Article 1.
