The Marion County Quorum Court held its regular meeting on December 10, 2019 at 6 p.m.

County Judge John Massey presided. All Justices were present except Justice McCalla.

Justice Brigham offered the invocation and Justice Madden led the pledge.

The regular meeting minutes were approved and all reports and committee reports were received and passed unanimously.

During the OEM report, Zach Davenport, temporary OEM director, stated that the radios were being update again, as the signals are bleeding in Missouri and near Russellville. The adjustments will bring the radios back into compliance with FCC regulations.

During the Solid Waste report, Stephen Elam reported that ADEQ had come and done an inspection and that no violations were found.

New Business:

Ordinance 2019-86 – 2020 Budget – Sponsored by the Budget Committee – This ordinance sets the budget for the county for the year 2020. A motion was made to read the ordinance by title only by Justice Scrima and seconded by Justice Mayo, the motion passed unanimously. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Mayo and seconded by Justice Nickels, this motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2019-87 – 2020 Numbers and Compensation – Sponsored by the Budget Committee - This ordinance sets the pay maximums for each county employee. The motion to read by title only was made by Justice Madden and seconded by Justice Mayo. This motion passed unanimously. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Madden and seconded by Justice Mayo. The motion was passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2019-88 – 2020 Numbers and Compensation for Elected Officials – Sponsored by the Budget Committee – This ordinance set the pay for each elected official in Marion County. The motion to read by title only was made by Justice Madden and seconded by Justice White. The motion passed unanimously. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Mayo and seconded by Justice Madden. The motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2019-89 – Judge and Jurors Postage – Sponsored by Justices Mayo, Scrima, and McCalla. – This ordinance moves money from the Judge’s office meals, miles and lodging line item to the County Clerk’s postage line item. Certified letters had been sent out for County Court Case 2019-1. This just gives the Clerk back her money. Also, this ordinance adds the line item for postage into the Juror’s and Witnesses category. And transfers money into that line item from the Jury Per Diem line item. The motion to read by title only was made by Justice Madden and seconded by Justice Shipman. The motion passed with Justice White voting present. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Madden and seconded by Justice Mayo. The motion passed with Justice White voting present.

Ordinance 2019-90 – Transfers for OEM and Transfer Station – Sponsored by Justice Madden – This ordinance reimburses for fuel from the Transfer Station and OEM to the Road Department. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Madden and seconded by Justice Mayo. The motion passed unanimously.

Ordinance 2019-91 – Numbers and Compensation for OEM – Sponsored by Justices Brigham and Nickels – This ordinance simply changes the position of the Emergency Management Director from salary to hourly. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Madden and seconded by Justice Scrima. The motion passed with Justice Mayo voting against it.

Ordinance 2019-92 – Courthouse Annex – Sponsored by Justices Nickels, Madden and Scrima – This ordinance moves money around to cover the expenses of the annex for the month of December. The motion to adopt was made by Justice Madden and seconded by Justice White. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion to read two resolutions by title only was made by Justice Vancuren and seconded by Justice Madden. The motion passed unanimously.

Resolution 2019-8 – Sheriff’s Department – Sponsored by Justice Madden – This resolution allows the County Judge to submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Economic Development Commission for purposes of securing grant funds in the amount of \$24,598.47 to aid and assist the Sheriff’s Department in purchasing body-worn cameras. The resolution passed unanimously with a voice vote.


Resolution 2019-9 – Pine Mountain Fire Department Grant – Sponsored by Justice Scrima – This resolution allows the County Judge to submit an application of formal request to the Arkansas Economic Development Commission for purposes of securing grant funds in the amount of \$25,500.00 to aid and assist the Pine Mountain Volunteer Fire Department in purchasing new bunker gear. The resolution passed unanimously with a voice vote.

The Court ratified three board positions. John Dyess was appointed to position 2 of the Marion County Regional Airport Board of Directors. Benjamin Crombie was appointed to a five year term, ending December 31, 2020, on the Marion County Fair and Livestock Show Board of Directors. Marcia Richardson was reappointed to the Library Board of Directors for a term ending December 31, 2025. Peggy Pentkowski was also appointed to the Library Board of Directors for a term ending December 31, 2021.


Justice Scrima has asked to be placed on the agenda to discuss former County Judge Terry Ott use of road funds to pay for his legal bills for his appeal from the ethics commission. Justice Scrima stated that the mis-spent monies should have come out of County General fund, rather than the road fund. He asked County Attorney Sam Pasting, what needed to be done to file a civil case against Terry Ott. Pasting replied that the court would have to hire outside council to represent the county in such a case. He stated that he would approach Jason Owen (AAC Attorney) for a list of outside councils. Justice Brigham asked about sending in an insurance claim. Pasting stated that he had looked into that, but that no claim could be filed, in this instance. Justice VanCuren made a motion for Pasting to pursue this action. The motion passed unanimously.

Judge Massey thanked everyone for their work during the past year.

The meeting was adjourned.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF MARION COUNTY, AR
